The Conference (10 speakers) portion will be held on Saturday June 10th at 8:00 AM and will conclude on Sunday June 11th by 1:00 PM. The Conference will be held at the Fulton-Montgomery Community College Theater, which is located in the Visual Arts and Communications Building.
